SEEKING JESUS TOGETHER

A QUIET TIME TOOL FOR CATALYST

Congratulations! You have in your hands the Quiet Time Tool we have specially designed to help us be "A Loving Community Seeking, Serving and Sharing Jesus!" We know spending time in God's Word (The Bible) daily is THE catalyst for equipping us to grow in faith as we "seek Jesus". We believe Jesus has real answers for life's real challenges!

Here's how it works:

- 1. Read the verses listed each day and take a moment to reflect on them. Write down in your own words anything that stands out—a theme, something new you noticed, etc.
- 2. **Ask**, "How does this apply to me?" From the reading, write down what you think God wants you to put into action in your life. Some days it may just be a "Wow! Praise God!"
- 3. **Pray** using the prayer prompt and add to it whatever is on your heart that day. You can pray before you start, after you have done the reading, or both!
- 4. **Share!** It's important to talk about what God is teaching you as you study His Word. Look for opportunities to do this in your social circles.

There you have it—pretty simple but SO important! Don't forget, we are praying for YOU!

Who is God, and what does He do?

This month's Quiet Time is a chance to pause, reflect, and turn your focus toward the living God—the One who's above all things and yet close to each of us. Our prayer is that these readings don't just fill your head with knowledge, but stir your heart with worship—drawing you closer to God in real and personal ways.

In a world full of changing opinions and shifting truths, the Bible gives us something solid: a clear picture of who God really is. Not the version we imagine, but the God who reveals Himself—powerful Creator, righteous Judge, gentle Shepherd, faithful Redeemer. He's not distant or detached. He steps into history and into our lives, with strength, mercy, and purpose.

Each Scripture this month shows a different glimpse of God's character—from His words to Moses to His hand in creation, from His justice to His compassion, from His promises to His glory revealed in Jesus. These aren't just big ideas—they're truths meant to change how we think, pray, and live.

At the heart of it all is this: knowing God leads to loving Him. And loving Him changes everything. May this month's time in the Word grow your trust, fuel your worship, and deepen your walk with the God who never changes.
