A QUIET TIME TOOL FOR CATALYST

Congratulations! You have in your hands the Quiet Time Tool we have specially designed to help us be “A Loving Community Seeking, Serving and Sharing Jesus!” We know spending time in God’s Word (The Bible) daily is THE catalyst for equipping us to grow in faith as we “seek Jesus”. We believe Jesus has real answers for life’s real challenges!

Here’s how it works:

- 1. Read the verses listed each day and take a moment to reflect on them. Write down in your own words anything that stands out—a theme, something new you noticed, etc.**
- 2. Ask, “How does this apply to me?” From the reading, write down what you think God wants you to put into action in your life. Some days it may just be a “Wow! Praise God!”**
- 3. Pray using the prayer prompt and add to it whatever is on your heart that day. You can pray before you start, after you have done the reading, or both!**
- 4. Share! It’s important to talk about what God is teaching you as you study His Word. Look for opportunities to do this in your social circles.**

There you have it—pretty simple but SO important! Don’t forget, we are praying for YOU!

Pray the Scriptures: 21 Days of Prayer

Prayer is the breath of the soul, and yet so often we find ourselves speechless. This month we will return to the ancient, Spirit-filled rhythm of praying the very words of God. This is not merely a devotional exercise—it is the shaping of a heart of prayer, grounded in the promises and language of Scripture.

To pray the Scriptures is to join a chorus that spans centuries. It is to step into the prayer-life of ancient prophets, psalmists, apostles and ordinary saints. They give to us a rich vocabulary of prayer which include prayers of lament, longing, confession, thanksgiving, intercession, and adoration. We will seek to align our prayers with God's will, saturated in His truth, and empowered by His Spirit which brings instruction AND intimacy as we slow down and listen. As we echo back to God His very Word, He forms within us a deeper hunger for His presence, a keener awareness of His voice, and a stronger confidence in His promises. THIS is how we practice the very presence of God and watch as He moves in and through our very lives!
